Suffolk Police & Crime Commissioner's Fund

The Suffolk Police and Crime Commissioner's Fund (replaces the previous Safer Suffolk Fund). Grants between £250 and £20,000 are available to support the work of voluntary and community groups, Charities, Social Enterprises and Community Interest Companies that are delivering services that help make Suffolk a safer place to live, work, travel and invest in.

If you are in receipt of a Safer Suffolk grant you cannot apply to this fund until you have fully spent and successfully reported on the expenditure of the grant. Please note there is still an exclusion for support services around domestic and sexual abuse as these have been supported via a separate funding stream.

Children & Young People's Emotional Health and Wellbeing Fund

Grants of up to £20,000 are available to support the work of voluntary, community and social enterprise organisations that are working to improve the emotional wellbeing of

children and young people in Suffolk, their families and carers. Funding is open to groups that operate within the boundaries of the West Suffolk Clinical Commissioning Group and Ipswich and East Suffolk Clinical Commissioning Group.

The closing date for this fund is **28th July 2017**.

Suffolk Rural Fund

- Community self-help
