2. Meet the AONBs Management Plans.
3. Enhances the landscape.
4. Has landowner permission/support.
5. Is a safe site to work at.

As the Coast & Heaths is still working in synch with the Stour Valley Volunteers, I will be scheduling mid-week work parties mainly for the 1st and 3rd Tuesday of the month (although there will be some flexibility if other days suit you better).
