**A. PARISH ACTIONPLAN**

**B. COASTAL PROTECTION**

The recent bad weather had caused the works to be stopped. Suffolk Coastal District Council are planning to undertake urgent coast protection works in addition to the ongoing phase 1 that have been done under emergency power.

The Phase 2 work will take place between the southern and northern ends of an existing gabion defence. This will involve the construction of a wall built from 2.4m by 1.4 m geo-textile bags filled with a mixture of sand and shingle taken from the beach either in the area of the works or from the Ness to the north of the village. The construction period will be approximately 12 weeks, subject to the weather and work is hoped to start March 2011.
