**4. REPORTS**

**a) DISTRICT COUNCILLORS SUFFOLK COUNTY COUNCILLOR -  
MR RICHARD SMITH**

He reported that things are quiet at the moment due to the 5<sup>th</sup> May Elections.

Mr Mark Bee had newly been appointed to Suffolk County Council and that there may be  
some changes made to certain services.

He was pleased to see that the new Village Gateways are almost completed.

**b) COASTAL PROTECTION - MR MIKE CHANDLER**

Work on Phase 1 is coming to a close. During the works they found out that the Brown  
coloured geotextile bags were made of a much stronger design than the white bags and  
probably over time this may make them less resilient. The tender documents and the  
legal agreement are still being finalised, making the Phase 2 work commencement a little  
later than previously hoped. A follow up meeting to the October 2010 meeting, is hoped  
to be arranged for early to mid June.

SUFFOLK COASTAL DISTRICT COUNCILLORS - MRS M. FELLOWES  
& MR R. WARREN

Mrs M. Fellowes reported that things at the moment are much quieter due to the Elections. She is quoted that she would be willing to speak on our behalf on any planning issues at the S.C.D.C. Development Control Meetings. She reported on the Ogilvie Hall that an Extraordinary Meeting has been arranged for 26<sup>th</sup> April 2011. Thanks were made to Mr Roger Warren for all his efforts and assistance that he has given to the Parish Council over the past years, as he is planning to move very shortly to be nearer his family.

c) LOCAL POLICE - PCSO TERRY BARROW

The report was read in Police Community Support Officer's absence.

There had been one reported crime since last meeting in March, which involved an alleged fraud. They are continuing to conduct speed checks all over Leiston & Aldeburgh Safer Neighbourhood area. He is seeking permission for himself and a colleague to attend The Meare on Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> July for their cycle and coding initiative between 1 pm and 4 pm. The 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Fun Day has been arranged for Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> June 2011 at King's Field, Aldeburgh.

C11/0297 Part of rear garden, 1 Hill Cottages, Aldeburgh Road, Aldringham Provision of air source heat pump to serve previously approved dwelling, support this application.

C11/0585 16 Lakeside Avenue, Thorpeness Erection of single-storey extension (revised application C04/1107). The meeting was closed proposed Mr Mayhew, seconded Mr Squirrell, this allowed a parishioner to speak concerning this application. The meeting reopened proposed Mr Squirrell, seconded Mr Mayhew. It was agreed to not support this application. The plans and information shown are incorrect to the description of the planning application.

C11/0619 Lancey Cottage, Aldeburgh Road, Aldringham Erection of extension to provide wheelchair accessible living accommodation including bedroom and specialist en suite facilities. New car port wheelchair accessible deck, support this application.

C11/0841 Heron Bank, Aldeburgh Road, Aldringham Conversion of detached garage to residential accommodation, support this application.

**The following planning applications were discussed after the Annual Parish Meeting these were supported and have also been approved by Suffolk Coastal District Council**

C11/0073 Old Thorpe House, Thorpe Road, Thorpeness Erection of two-storey extension, porch and dormer windows.

C/11/0055 Beacon Hill Barn, Beacon Hill Lane, Thorpeness Replacement of three windows and set of double doors and creation of new window to North West elevation.

**The following planning applications have been approved by S.C.D.C.**

C09/1264 Cliff House Caravan Site, Sizewell Road, Aldringham-cum-Thorpe Variation of condition on planning permission C08/2204 to allow an additional 5 static caravan pitches, erection of a storage shed and alterations to the car parking area.

C11/ 0225 Logwood, Aldeburgh Road, Aldringham Erection of single-storey rear extension.

C10/3143 Thorpeness Beach, Church Road, Thorpeness Strengthening of existing failed gabion structure using a combination of sand filled geotextile bags and localised rock infill. Fill material will be sourced in front of the structure from the beach or an agreed amount of material from the Ness to the north. The existing structure will require infill of rock, secured using mesh to repair failed sections of gabion.
