

Hedgerow Survey

The Hedgerow Survey of Aldringham-cum-Thorpe-with-Sizewell Parish was successfully completed within nine months thanks to the hardwork and enthusiasm of over 20 volunteer surveyors.

The hedges received a thorough examination of the different species of hardwood trees within them; the hedges' structure and condition, and any adjacent features of interest.

Last December our findings were given to Mr. Guy Ackers, the County Co-ordinator, who commended our survey as one of the best so far completed. He hinted that funds might eventually be made available for improving the hedges which are largely in poor condition.

Our thanks are due to Mr. Glen Ogilvie for permission to carry out the survey on his land, and also to the farmers for their co-operation.
