## **Minutes**

Approx 27 people attended plus visitors from AGNES

### **1. Welcome and Introduction of Guest Speaker**

Ben O'Dwyer welcomed the steering committee, volunteers and 'clients' including two volunteers from Aldeburgh Good Neighbours, Ian and Susan Henderson. Ben then introduced our Guest Speaker, Lynn Butler from CATS who spoke about the services they offer and the changes that were being introduced in June 2016, which may affect us all. After Lynn had finished her talk, Ben thanked her and advised that the steering committee would keep in touch with her with respect to the changes taking place so that we may keep our handbook up to date.

2. **Apologies** were received from the Atkinsons, Roger Searle and Jill Hubbard.

3. **The Minutes of the 2015 AGM** were approved and signed.

### **4. Chairman's Report**

Ben O'Dwyer advised the meeting that tasks were surprisingly close to those before transportation to the hospital stopped. Ben also reminded us that the informality of the GNS structure allowed us a good deal of freedom.

### **5. Treasurer's Report**

Sydney Graham presented the **Treasurer's Report**. General Donations of £378.51 last year, £200 of which was gratefully received from the Parish Council. In fact all donations were gratefully received. Slightly down from the year before, however, in addition to

the General Donations, £300 was raised for the Memorial Plaque to Val Allport plus an overage of £100 with which we purchased LED lights for the Christmas Tree in front of the Meare, which Val had started. Expenses on the other hand were very much less than the year before.

## 6. **Election of the Steering Group**

With the exception of Mick Sturmey and Jane McLaughlin who were stepping down from the steering group, nominations had been received for the balance of the steering group, (Ben O'Dwyer, Jill Hubbard, Pippa McLardy, Peter Holmes, Sydney Graham and David Parratt) to form the next steering group, together with the inclusion of two further nominations for Wendy Sturmey and Christine Laschet. Proposed by Hazel Searle and seconded by Mike Trapp, the nominations were unanimously carried.
